Reflections from the Vicar

This year the celebration of Palm Sunday occurs on April 10th. It commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem and sets the stage for the events of Holy Week. Our prayer book begins this feast day with a collect (prayer) that emphasizes “the contemplation of those mighty acts, whereby we have been given life and immortality.”¹ Then during Holy Week, the word ‘remembrance’ rings throughout our liturgy. For example, in our Maundy Thursday service, Jesus, on the night before he died for us, said, “Do this in remembrance of me.”² The original word used for ‘remembrance’ signifies “a deliberate recollection, made to better appreciate the effects of what happened.”³ My liturgical professor in seminary remarked that this recollection is intended to present those events so vividly that they can be connected not just to our minds but also our hearts and emotions. Therefore, let us pray that the celebration of these events would inspire the surrender of “ourselves, our souls, and bodies”⁴ with gratefulness, love, and sincere devotion. Amen.
