ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORK TO BE PUT ON HOLD

The construction work on Route 211 and the widening of Seven Lakes Drive will soon be put on hold to accommodate the 2024 US Open Golf Tournament scheduled for June 2024 in Pinehurst.

Clearing and preparation have been underway for a number of months. Focus will now be on making the route leading into Pinehurst functional and attractive to accommodate tournament traffic.

The delay in widening Seven Lakes Drive means the frontage of our building will not be disturbed until after the US Open, though we could expect some utility work during that time. The delay will provide extra planning time for what's next for St. MM Church.

In a prayer for travelers, our prayer book guides us to address our "Heavenly Father, whose glory fills the whole creation, and whose presence we find wherever we go."ⁱ God's purpose in showing us a glimpse of his glory is to remind us who we are as his children and strengthen us for our purpose in life. The Apostle Paul, in his letter to the Ephesians, writes, "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."ⁱⁱ

The word for “workmanship” in Greek is poiéma,ⁱⁱⁱ from which we get our English words “poem” and “poetry.” Poetry is art, and art expresses what is most valuable to its creator.

Therefore, as you take a break from your usual routines this Summer, let us be careful not to take a break from what God has in store for you. He not only wants to inspire you with the beauty of his creation but also with a renewed vision of your calling to reflect his glory to others.
