Reflections from the Vicar:

This year the Church calendar for March is jam-packed. In it, we will complete our Lenten season with Palm Sunday on March 24th and Easter Sunday on March 31st. The scope of the readings calls for "All the ends of the earth to remember and turn to the Lord."ⁱⁱ For example, our Prayer Book

liturgy for Palm Sunday encourages us "to enter with joy upon the contemplation of those mighty acts, whereby you have given us life and immortality."ⁱⁱ Then, the liturgies of Holy Week bring us to the cross as a place of refuge. The well-known hymn, "In the cross of Christ I glory," says it beautifully. "All the light of sacred story gathers round its head sublime."ⁱⁱⁱ

Therefore, let us pray that celebrating these events would "lead us to the rock that is higher than I,"^{iv} for that is the goal of our Lenten journey. *Amen*

AN INVITATION FROM ANDREA


