INVITATION TO LENTEN STUDY

“All Shall Be Well”: Living into God’s Will with Julian of Norwich

Please plan to attend our Lenten study program after coffee hour on the first four Sundays of Lent. Vicki Derka will present a series of lessons focused on the writings of 14th-century mystic Julian of Norwich. After a brief introduction to Julian’s life and writings—the earliest surviving works in English written by a woman—we will immerse ourselves in selections from those writings. Specifically, we will examine her ideas as they relate to our own lives, leading us to a deeper experience of Lenten discipline. We will be guided through experiences of pain and loss as a means of coming closer to God and to achieving the philosophy famously espoused by Julian: “All shall be well. All shall be well. All manner of things shall be well.”

If you wish to learn more about Julian’s thought, the vestry has offered to supply copies of *The Drawing of This Love*:

Growing in Faith with Julian of Norwich by the Rev. Robert Fruewirth. A former priest director at the Julian Centre in Norwich, England, Fr.
